# WHY LATIN AMERICA AND AFRICA?

According to the World Health Organization (WHO), over one billion people worldwide are facing a "critical shortage in healthcare."



**250** MILLION PEOPLE

250 million people in South America are suffering from a non-communicable disease, such as cancer, diabetes, or cardiovascular disease.



**274** MILLION PEOPLE

274 million people in Latin America and the Caribbean do not have health insurance.



**80%** DEATH FROM CERVICAL CANCER

In 2000, there were over 288,000 deaths from cervical cancer worldwide. Approximately 80% of these deaths occurred in developing countries.



**88%** DIARRHOEAL DEATHS

88% of diarrhoeal deaths worldwide are the result of unsafe water, and inadequate sanitation and hygiene.



**60** AVERAGE LIFE EXPECTANCY

Global life expectancy at birth in 2015 was 60 years in the WHO African Region and 76.8 years in the WHO European Region, giving a ratio of 1.3 between the two regions.



**10+** MILLION PEOPLE

More than 10 million people in Africa live on less than \$1 per day, the so-called food poverty line below which people are unable to purchase enough food for an adequate diet.



**50** MILLION ORPHANED

There are approximately 50 million orphaned children in Africa, most of them HIV-positive.



**24%** GLOBAL DISEASE


Sub-Saharan Africa accounts for 11 percent of the world's population, yet bears 24 percent of the global disease burden and commands less than one percent of global health expenditure.

# Listening.

## SECSENCALLA: OUR LONG-TERM COMMUNITY PARTNERSHIP IN CUSCO

At MEDLIFE, every development project starts with listening to the community. Over time, we establish trust and confidence through our Mobile Clinics and Educational Workshops. This approach empowers the community to share their needs with us, so that we can use our time and resources to make the greatest possible impact.

Every community we work with has its own unique challenges. When we begin working with a new community, they sometimes lack clearly defined goals and struggle to reach a consensus on their priorities. Our local staff build the capacity of these communities by supporting them to organize and unite. This process takes time, and that's why we strongly believe that creating long-term relationships with our partner communities is essential..

An example of this approach in action can be seen in the community of Union Santa Fe, located in Villa Maria del Triunfo, Lima, Peru, whose history can be read in our 2016 Annual Report. With this successful relationship in mind, our team in Cusco decided to focus on building a long-term relationship with a community in Cusco. The community chosen was Secsencalla: A village of 80 families located 40 minutes from the city of Cusco.

Our first community meeting with Secsencalla was at the end of 2017. The local municipality of Andahuaylillas had recommended that we visit before holding a Mobile Clinic. This meeting not only allowed us to spark the community's interest in Educational Workshops and Mobile Clinics, but also gave us an opportunity to connect with community members and begin to articulate a collaborative model of working together.

One of the initiatives we implemented in Secsencalla was The Healthy Homes Program. This program is comprised of three stages that we hope to continue carrying out in the coming years. The first stage focuses on the health of the families and aims to build fuel efficient stoves to prevent respiratory disease, which is a common illness in the region. In the future stages, we will implement projects to empower community members financially, and to create public spaces for family recreation.

The road to eradicating poverty in Secsencalla is long, but thanks to the support of our Chapters, volunteers, and staff, we are making great strides in this direction. In 2018, we built 37 fuel efficient stoves, which will allow families to enjoy their homes and kitchens safely.



## MEDLIFE COMMUNITY ADVOCATE: RICARDO CCASANI



Ricardo Ccasani lives and breathes the MEDLIFE vision. As a teenager, he moved to Lima from Huacavelica, one of the poorest regions of Peru. Before long, he became the leader of his new community, Union Santa Fe. Working side by side with MEDLIFE, Ccasani led the way on development projects in his community, from constructing staircases to organizing fellow community members. Now a full time MEDLIFE staff member, Ccasani draws upon his lived experience and deep understanding of local communities to advocate for equal access to healthcare, education, and a safe home. Get to know Ccasani in the following interview:

### How did you get involved in MEDLIFE?

I first met MEDLIFE when they were building a staircase in a nearby community. At first, I was hesitant to reach out to them because in Peru, some non-profits just take photos of the neighborhood while giving very little support. After I met Carlos Benavides (Director of MED Programs Peru), I realized that MEDLIFE was different. They taught us how to work together and get organized. At the time, it was a challenge for me as the community leader but we managed to show everyone what we were capable when we worked together.

### What makes MEDLIFE's work different from other organizations?

MEDLIFE is always at the community's side, for the duration of a project and beyond.

MEDLIFE also encourages community members to take ownership of each project by collaborating and going 50-50 with them. When MEDLIFE and Union Santa Fe started collaborating, MEDLIFE spent many hours, often at night, working together with us. They motivated and supported the leaders and the wider community. MEDLIFE's presence at night meetings also sets it apart from other organizations. During the evening, when the working day is over, you can meet with more community members. This means we can have better discussions and hear everyone's opinions and points of view. Another big difference is that MEDLIFE treats each community like family and people can feel this.

### What has been the most impactful MEDLIFE project for you?

The water project was really impactful because these kinds of projects really benefit communities. Each staircase project is also impactful because you can see the difference they make in the community after they are built. It leads to true development because without staircases, it is complicated to access these communities.

### What do you like most about your job at MEDLIFE?

Definitely working with the communities and helping them to develop their projects. I really enjoy sharing the knowledge I've gained as a community leader and as a MEDLIFE staff member.

#### *Lima Nurse*



# Meet Juan Jose.

We first met Juan José at a Medical Clinic in 2017. He presented with scars that had left him partially disfigured and prevented him from moving his head freely. His family explained that this was a result of burns to his face, neck, and chest that he sustained from an accident when he was just four years old. The MEDLIFE doctor recommended surgery to recover Juan José's mobility in his neck.

However, it wasn't until MEDLIFE nurse Carmen visited Juan José's home that we discovered the full extent of the challenges he was facing. The family was living in destitute conditions and nearly all of them were suffering from malnutrition. Part of the reason for this was that Juan José's father was unemployed and struggled with alcoholism. The whole family depended on Juan José's mother's income from her work as a farmhand.

The family's struggles were worsened when Juan José's sister fell unexpectedly pregnant. If Juan José was going to have a successful recovery after his surgery, and his sister was going to give birth to a healthy baby, the entire family's living situation would need to be drastically improved. Carmen gained the trust of the family and continued to provide medicines and prenatal care.

In April 2018, the MEDLIFE Cusco team worked hand in hand with volunteers to bring a Mobile Clinic to a community close to Juan José's home. As the clinic was winding down the for the day, we decided to visit Juan José' and his family. We were joined by Cynthia, a long time MEDLIFE from Vermont Tech. As we made our way down the dirt road, Juan José's home came into sight.

When we saw the house, we realized that the family's living situation had worsened. The house was typical of the region and consisted of two small buildings (a kitchen and a storeroom/bedroom) made out of adobe bricks. However, the walls and ceiling had been covered in plastic tarp to prevent rainwater from leaking into the bedroom. Inside the house, we noticed that the beds that the family slept on were not mattresses, but large pieces of yellow foam set on top of wood pallets.

After witnessing the challenges the family faced, Cynthia decided to take action. After returning to the US, she worked with her MEDLIFE Chapter at Vermont Tech to raise over \$500 for the family. These funds covered the extra costs associated with Juan José's surgery and enabled us to renovate the family's home. As a result of the collaboration between MEDLIFE staff and MEDLIFE Vermont Tech, Juan José had a comfortable place to recover from his surgery and the family was able to enjoy living together in a safe home.

# Meet Rosa.

In July 2018, MEDLIFE inaugurated the Morocho family's house in Laderas de Nueva Esperanza, a community located in the outskirts of Villa Maria del Triunfo, Lima, Peru. There were smiles, laughter, and tears as we reflected on the challenges we had faced together and the new friendships we made along the way. But, how did it all begin?

In 2017, the MEDLIFE team was building a water reservoir in Laderas de Nueva Esperanza when we met Nicol, a nine-year-old girl who lived nearby. Little by little, she won over our hearts and shared her story with us.

Nicol woke up early every day to take care of her mom, Rosa. Rosa had never been able to walk and could barely use her right arm because of an undiagnosed disability she'd had since she was a child. Taking care of her mom was a big responsibility for a nine-year-old girl, and it left Nicol with limited time to play, grow, and learn. Thanks to MEDLIFE's support, Rosa was able to visit a doctor and receive a diagnosis. The doctor explained that she was a victim of Polio, a virus that can spread to the nervous system causing irreparable damage and paralysis. Although there was no medical treatment that could cure Rosa's disability, MEDLIFE worked to support Rosa in other ways.

Rosa's home wasn't designed for someone with a disability, and Rosa moved around by crawling on the floor with her one functional arm. With that in mind, MEDLIFE renovated the house to create a healthy home for Rosa and Nicol. We added light switches close to the ground, a disabled bathroom with a sink close to the ground, and ramps instead of stairs. With a renovated home, Rosa could now be safe on her own while Nicol went to school.

When the house's inauguration day finally arrived, we blew up balloons and decorated everything to mark the celebration. Then, with Nicol by our side, we broke a bottle of champagne and celebrated.

A week later, we visited the house and Nicol greeted us with a BIG smile on her face. It was heartwarming to see how they had settled into their new home and made it their own. Before we left, they let us know how grateful they were to all the volunteers, staff, and donors for making one of their dreams come true. Nicol even showed us how much her grades had improved, and we were so proud!

# Bathrooms in Kilimanjaro

We are proud to present a new MEDLIFE project in Kilimanjaro! Thanks to the hard work of our MEDLIFE team we were able to make much-needed improvements to Kilema Primary School, a school that will benefit more than 200 students and teachers in the community of Kilema.

Kilema is a community of just over 20,000 inhabitants located in the region of Kilimanjaro. During a mobile clinic nearby, the director of the local school petitioned for MEDLIFE's support with constructing new school bathrooms.. The toilets that were being used at the school presented a health risk, as they were dirty and lacked a proper drainage system. As a result, many children had stomach complications which caused them to miss class. The new toilets have improved the students' health and increased school attendance rates!

# Safe Water in Riobamba

Between May and June of 2018, the MEDLIFE Ecuador team built 5 water reservoirs in the community of Llinlin Las Juntas, Ecuador. This project was one of the largest we'd ever executed in Ecuador! In the following interview, Martha Chicaiza (Director of MEDLIFE Ecuador and our first staff member) explains how this project came to be.

### Why did you decide to construct water reservoirs in this community?

We decided to construct the reservoirs after listening to the community. We had already established a relationship with them because we had previously held Mobile Clinics there. They explained to us that they were experiencing health problems because they lacked clean water. After a water quality evaluation confirmed the urgency of this project, we began working with the community and the local municipality to design the water reservoirs. The construction costs were shared amongst everyone involved.

Here in Riobamba, many communities lack access to clean drinking water. Locals use water from moors and streams but this can lead to diseases like chronic diarrhea, which is one of the leading causes of child deaths worldwide.

### How did you plan and develop this project?

We worked hand in hand with the community, Mobile Clinic volunteers, and the municipality to develop and carry out all five stages of this project. It was hard work for the volunteers, but we were all motivated by the hope of bringing safe drinking water to the community. Thanks to this determination, we successfully completed and inaugurated the reservoirs.

### How has this project impacted the community?

This project has facilitated the orderly and strategic distribution of water in the community. Now, the municipality is able to monitor and supervise water consumption. The community also has a better understanding of the importance of drinking clean water at home.

Since completing this project, the number of infections caused by drinking unsafe water has reduced. Children no longer need to fetch water before school, as it goes directly to their homes. This gives them more time to study and play!

Perhaps the most important outcome is that the community now understands that access to clean drinking water is a vital right of every human being.

# THE MED VIDA DENTAL CLINIC



The MED Vida Dental Clinic is a project that emerged in early 2018 in the Villa María del Triunfo district of Lima, Peru.

The objective of the MED Vida Dental Clinic is to provide services to families that lack access to quality dental healthcare. Open 6 days a week, MED Vida is fully staffed by expert local dentists and complete with technological equipment. In addition to providing 70 different types of dental treatments, MED Vida educates the community on the importance of dental hygiene to help patients understand, prevent, and treat oral health conditions.

MED Vida Dental Clinic also serves as a way for us to provide Dental Follow-Up care to patients we meet at Mobile Clinics at either a subsidized price or free of cost.

Services provided by the MED Vida Dental Clinic include:

- Orthodontics (brackets)
- Dental aesthetics (veneers - design)
- Oral Rehabilitation (Prosthesis)
- Implants
- Surgeries
- Pediatric dentistry (children)
- Geriatric dentistry (elders)
- Endodontics
- Whitening
- Periodontics
- Prophylaxis

Introducing our new Service Learning Trips:

## Dental Clinic

Dental Clinic is a week-long Service Learning Trip where students will support local dentists while providing dental screening and treatment to communities in Lima's urban settlements and in the MED Vida Dental Clinic. During MEDLIFE Mobile Clinics, the Dental Station is consistently one of the most-requested services, but the dentists are only able to treat 15 patients a day. With a specialty Dental Clinic, we can expand our reach and provide quality dental care to more people.

During Dental Clinic, students will have the chance to work interactively with patients and dentists by performing a variety of roles including patient registration, station set-up, instrument preparation, and shadowing dentists throughout procedures like extractions, fillings, and cleanings. Students will also have the opportunity to lead adolescent dental education workshops.



## Development Corps

Historical, social, and political factors combined with a lack of urban planning have led to a rise in the informal land occupation on the outskirts of Lima, Peru. Members of these communities seek safe public spaces for recreation and leisure, but the inhospitable land, scarcity of public space, and a lack of financial resources have continued to get in the way of progress. MEDLIFE is working to change that through Development Corps.

Development Corps is a week-long Service Learning Trip that allows students interested in architecture, engineering, and community development to volunteer in Peru. You will work hand in hand with local professionals and community members on a development project in urban settlements on the outskirts of Lima, Peru. Your trip will empower impoverished communities by constructing safe public spaces where kids can play, young people can hang out with their friends, and families can spend time together.
