Everyone did such an amazing job with Moving Mountains, we are excited to introduce our next project.

MEDLIFE, with the support of newly created Chapters, hopes to help lift this community out of poverty. The young families in Laderas de Amancaes, with MEDLIFE and Chapters, hope to create a mini MED Center that would create a safe space for children, and a physical home base for community development project planning, healthcare services, and more. This is because the closest nursery, health center, markets, etc are very far away. Additionally, the creation of new Chapters could support other projects like retention walls that take community members closer to obtaining land title. Without legal rights to their land, families are unable to apply for formal loans and do not receive many government benefits. The lack of land title brings insecurity and inhibits personal development.
